How is Dia De Los Muertos celebrated? By Eddie Hernandez and Familia

Dia De Los Muertos (Day of the Dead), is widely celebrated in Mexico over multiple days, coinciding with All Saint's Day and Halloween. My family never celebrated it until the movie Coco was released in 2017, after which our daughter Aria questioned why we didn't celebrate it?

The centerpiece of the celebration is the ofrenda (altar), which is used to place photos of those we've lost. In addition to photos, sometimes we place food and beverages, and trinkets and symbols of things that remind us of those souls, and/or things they enjoyed doing. From our family, you'll notice fishing lures and dice, as my father's parents enjoyed trips to Las Vegas and Reno, whereas my mom's parents enjoyed fishing.

The ofrenda is intended to be colorful and celebratory, hence the serape (brightly colored Mexican blanket), and is traditionally lit with candles and decorated with marigolds (sometimes called Flor de Muerto, or Flower of the Dead), along with calaveras (skulls).

For us, it is intended to affirm the connection we've had with those we've lost, so that they are not forgotten. The photos and symbols provide a spark to those memories; "Hey, remember the time that Grandma told a long winded joke, but completely forgot the punchline?" I don't remember the joke, but I remember all of us crying, bent over with laughter, especially Grandpa. You had to be there, and we were.

We are honored to share this tradition with Trinity, and invite anyone to participate by bringing photos, trinkets etc to place on the ofrenda.
